Required Dress Code & Shoes

All attire listed below help both teachers and dancers to be aware of proper body placement while dancing, and aids in the ability to properly observe and correct positioning to avoid injury. Note: Dance shoes should only be worn in the studio to avoid bringing in debris.

Hair: All students must wear their hair pulled back and **securely fastened** in a ponytail or a secure bun for ballet. Students with short hair should fasten the hair back away from their face. **Secure Hair means that it will not require a re-do throughout class!**

Jewelry: No jewelry is permitted in class, as it is best for the safety of the dancers.

NEW THIS YEAR: We are requiring all classes listed below to purchase their shoes through our website ordering system. This will ensure that everyone has the same shoes, creating a uniform look. Please visit: <https://www.stilladance.com/shop> to order shoes. All shoes must be sized by Miss Angie prior to ordering, as there are no refunds on shoes.

You may wear your old shoes in class until it is time to get new shoes. Students will need to purchase shoes in time to have them in hand with enough time to break them in before recital.

Level II & III Classes

Girls Attire: Black leotard, pink/tank tights, black dance skirt (ballet), black shorts (jazz & tap), knit sweater and optional leg warmers.

Boys Attire: White t-shirt, black jazz pants or shorts.

Musical Theater, Kid Hop, Tumbling

Tumbling: Dancers should wear convertible/ footless tights and bare feet, or shoes from last year.

Musical Theater: Dancers can wear any jazz shoe for class, we will determine color of shoes once costumes are selected.
